1. Minutes of meeting held on 11th February 2019

1. Purchase of FreeholdTitle of The Old School House.

The Clerk presented a letter from the current owner seeking to purchase the freehold of the house and land attached. Cllrs discussed the issue and asked the Clerk to seek clarification from LCC, CBC, and SRBC regarding valuation and possible development of the site in the near future

3 Clayton Landfill Site.

Cllr Whitham updated the Council members on recent developments. Apparently the management has changed and ther had been no further breaches. Cllr Whitham reported that the Environment Agency will continue to monitor the site until the end of June 2019.

1. R & B Burscough Charity

However if the Council joined CPRE the annual cost would be £36.00 pa. Council resolved to join CPRE.
